She profusely thanked the Management and the members of the General Body for their cooperation and encouragement.
2. Prof. Pramod Muthalik read out the proceedings of the previous meeting.
3. The response to the Post-Graduate courses in Kannada, Sociology and Computer Science were encouraging. The proposal to start PG courses in English, Electronics and Economics was unanimously approved by the members.

The Committee has unanimously suggested the introduction of CBCS pattern for the UG courses and all Heads of the Departments must take necessary steps to implement the same.

The Principal urged the faculty to avail the research facilities in the FIU and submit papers for the same and informed the members that the Departments of Kannada and Sociology were taking active measures to obtain recognition as a Research Centre.

Members discussed the need for a Workshop to train the faculty and students for competitive examinations. The Principal told the members to conduct Gender empowerment programs. The regular discussions regarding the semester continuous internal assessment, tests, seminars and end semester examinations were discussed.

She thanked the members for their patient hearing and valuable suggestions given by them.
