- > Dr. Mariyappa opined that the choices offered to students are limited.
- > Sri. Krishna Chartered Accountant suggested that college should take steps to introduce courses.
- > Dr. Muninarayanappa suggested that business mathematics and Statistics must change the name as QTBD 1 & 2 for the both semester.
- > Dr. Muninarayanappa also suggested that Business Ethics unit one and three changes.
- ▶ Prof. Nataraj suggested Mathematics can be a subject in the ^{3rd} semester and all the members agreed.
- > Dr. Muninarayappa opined that the commerce subjects in our B.Com course are getting diluted.
- ➤ **Dr.**Ravikumar. R suggested to change in the financial Accounting 5th unit as Hire Purchase system and in Advanced financial accounting 5th unit as conversion of partnership to final account.

- > Dr. Mariyappa spoke about the credits, compared them to university and remarked that our credit is double. So he suggested altering the credits to match the university credits.
- > Dr. Mariyappa opined that the choices offered to students are limited.
- > Sri. Krishna Chartered Accountant suggested that college should take steps to introduce integrated courses.
- > Dr. Muninarayanappa suggested that business mathematics be the core subject without choice. Let the mathematics be simple because mathematics plays an important role.
- > Dr. Muninarayanappa also suggested that Business Ethics in not required because the students are not exposed to the corporate environment.
- Prof. Nataraj suggested Mathematics can be a subject in the 3rd semester and all the members agreed.
- > Dr. Muninarayappa opined that the commerce subjects in our B.Com course are getting diluted.

- ➤ Dr. Mariyappa advised to implement the meaning, objectives and advantages of Accounting Standard in the first unit in the 1st Semester.
- > Dr. Mariyappa recommended and all agreed to change the Financial Accounting 5th unit to Hire Purchases and Installment (Theory only). And in 4th unit the sub-lease should be excluded.
- > Dr. Sreekanteswara suggested that only asset accrual method should be in hire purchase.
- > Dr. Mariyappa suggested changingthe title of optional paper Part-I as Business Ethics and Part-II as Business Communication.
- ➤ Mr. Krishna Chartered Accountant suggested changing the business communication unit-5 based on companies Act of 2013.
- Dr.Mariyappa recommended changingAdvanced Financial accounting last unit as Conversion of Partnership Firms into Ltd Co., and removingIntroduction to Accounting Standard topic to make the unit 12 hours.
- > Dr. Mariyappa also suggested changing 5th unit to Departmental Accounts 8 hours.
- > Dr. Umakant suggested that Conversion of Partnership Firms into Ltd Co should be in first unit so that students will get knowledge about assets and liabilities.
- > Sri. Krishna and Dr. Muninarayanappa suggested modifying Skill Development to include visits to different department stores.
- \triangleright Dr. Mariyappa suggested changing number of units in BRM to 5 units only and he said to merge 1st and 2nd unit and alter the hours.
- > Dr. Mariyappa suggested that Skill Development should include the Drafting of Synopsis.
- > Dr. Mariyappa suggested changing BCA Financial Accounting first unit name as Introduction to Financial Accounting. He also suggested removing the topic on Accounting Standard completely.
