The Board of Studies resolved to restructure the syllabi of M.AEconomics for PG coursesunder the newly proposed choice-based credit and semester systemfrom the academic year 2015-16. The restructuring of the new syllabus emphasized on self-learning through Research oriented and skill development activities for the student paving the way for a qualitative transformation of the existing system. While attempting the reforms, the existing conditions relating to infrastructure, work load and staff pattern was taken into consideration.

1.
