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### Proceedings of BoS Meeting M.A Economics was held on 25-07-2015

The Board of Studies resolved to restructure the syllabi of M.A Economics for PG courses under the newly proposed choice-based credit and semester system from the academic year 2015-16. The restructuring of the new syllabus emphasized on self-learning through Research oriented and skill development activities for the student paving the way for a qualitative transformation of the existing system. While attempting the reforms, the existing conditions relating to infrastructure, work load and staff pattern was taken into consideration.

1. The newly proposed choice-based credit and semester system the teaching hours for a course in each semester was approved as 54 hours and the Semester-wise scheme of papers, syllabus and grading was organized keeping in mind the interest of the students and the contemporary relevance of Economics.
