


Students' Feedback Report



The report will be placed before the acedemic council for continuous improvement in the areas where the questions are underperforming.




The contribution of alumni to the activities of the University is substantial especially in the development of the curriculum. Nearly 346 alumni were given their feedback for the following Questionnaire:





The report will be placed before the academic council for continuous improvement in the areas where the questions are underperforming.


Teachers' Feedback Report:


