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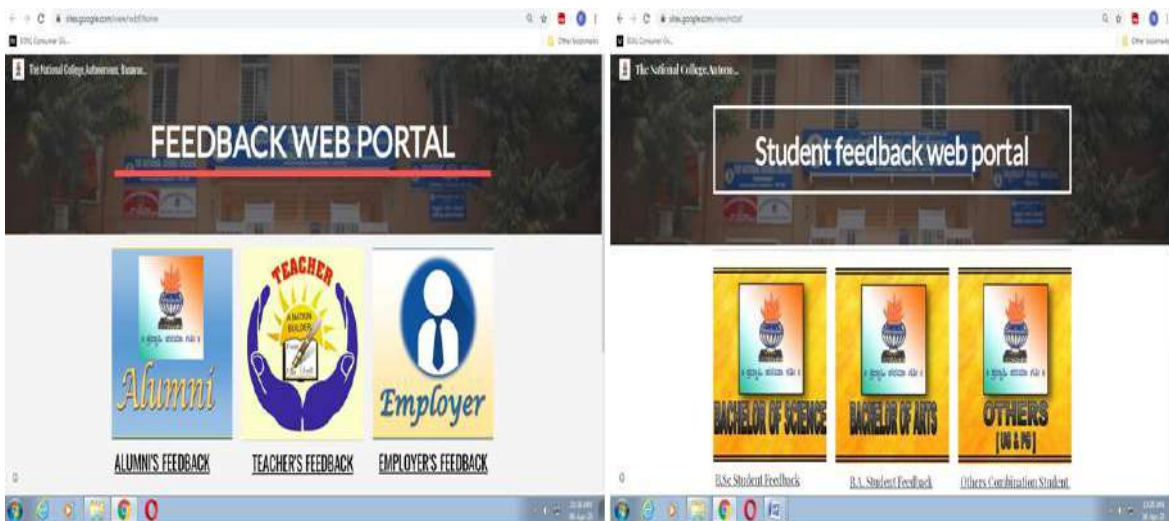

Majority of the student (56%) agreed that the syllabus is Excellent. Around 31% of the students agreed that the content provided in the syllabus is very Good. It is observed that 11% of the respondents agreed that the courses are in tune with Good. The students' feedback revealed that 1% of them agreed Bad and only 1% students' agreed Poor.

The analysis of the students' feedback clearly depicts that they are well satisfied with the curriculum development and revision. It is observed from the students' feedback that few of them expressed the need of more classroom learning-centric facilities.

Alumni Feedback Report:

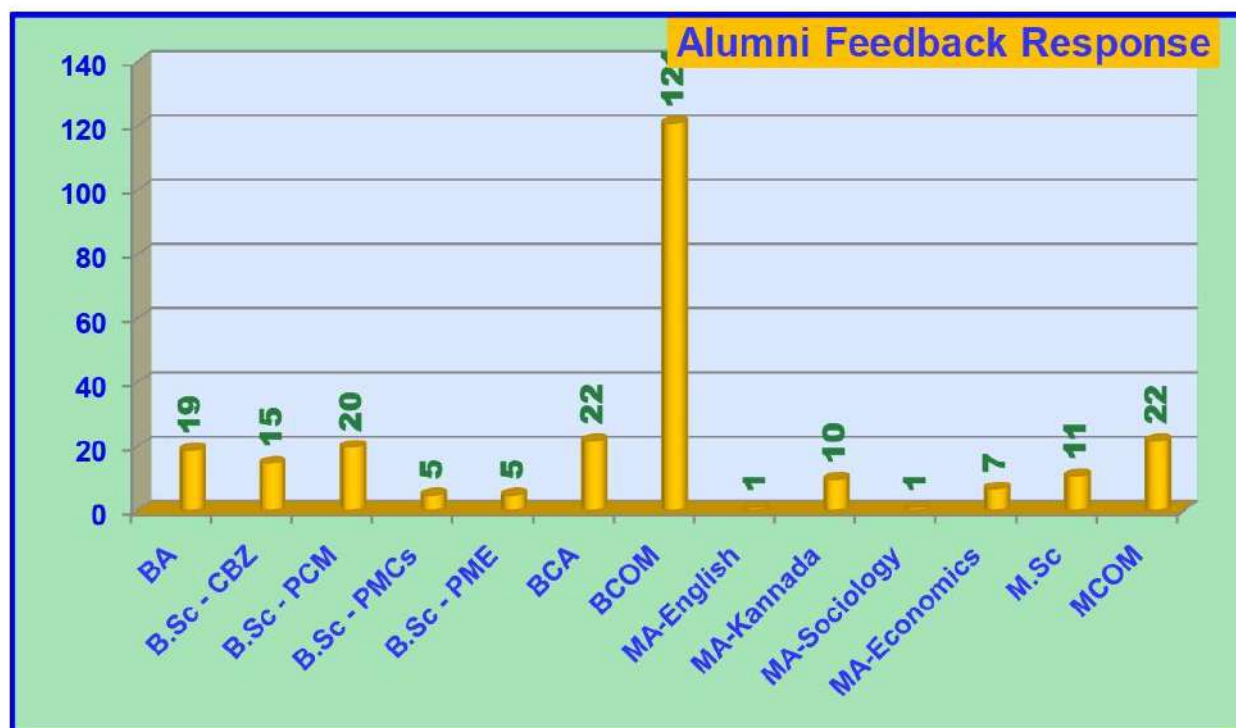
The contribution of alumni to the activities of the University is substantial especially in the development of the curriculum. Nearly 259 alumni were given their feedback for the following Questionnaire:

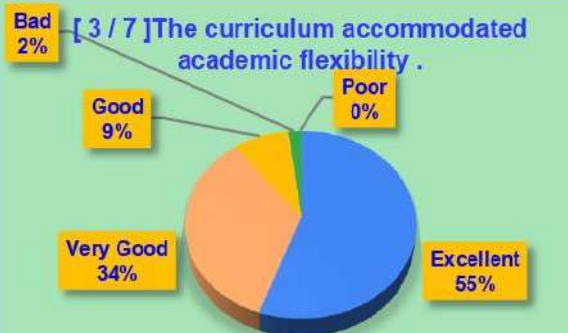

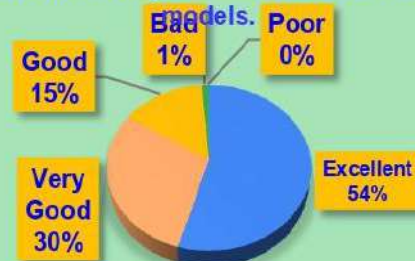

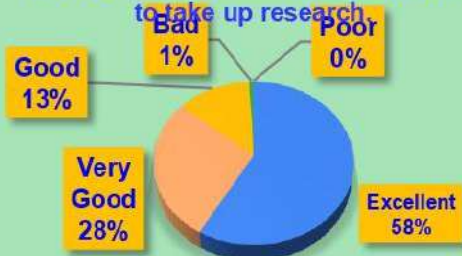

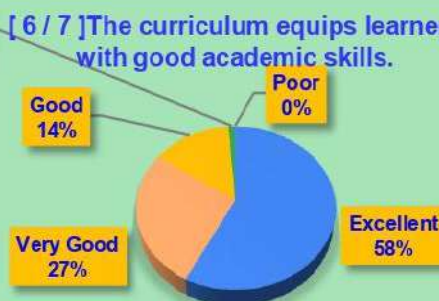

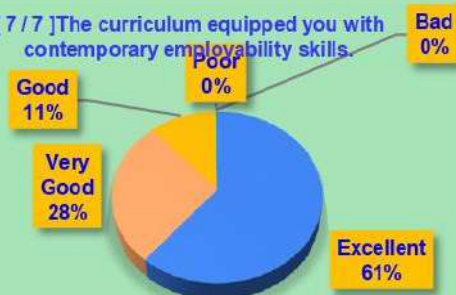

Teachers' Feedback Report:

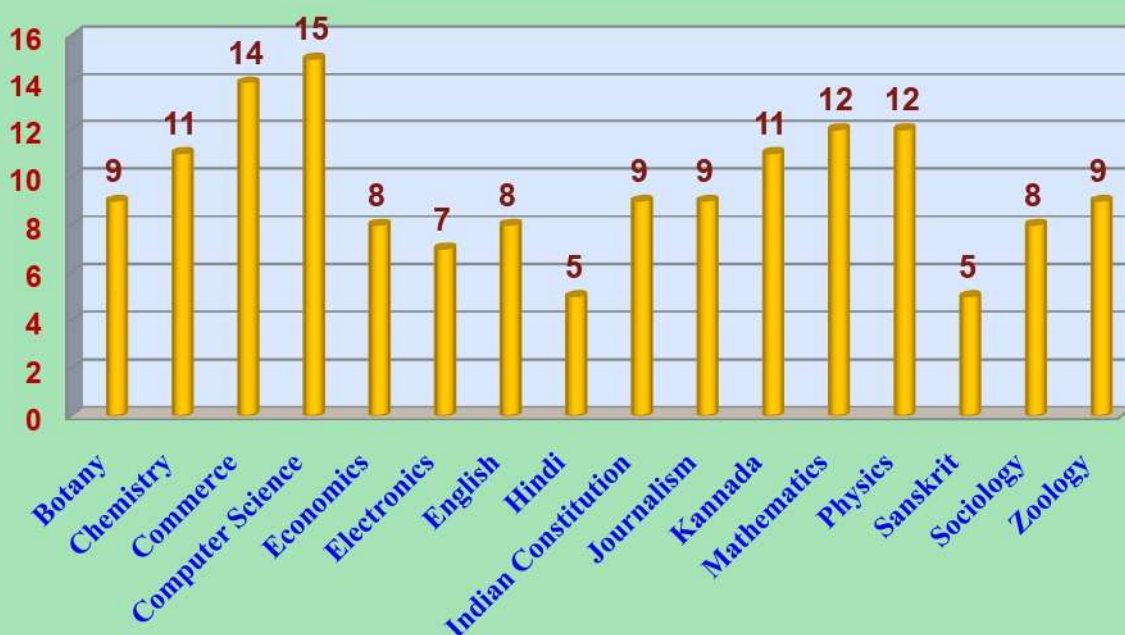

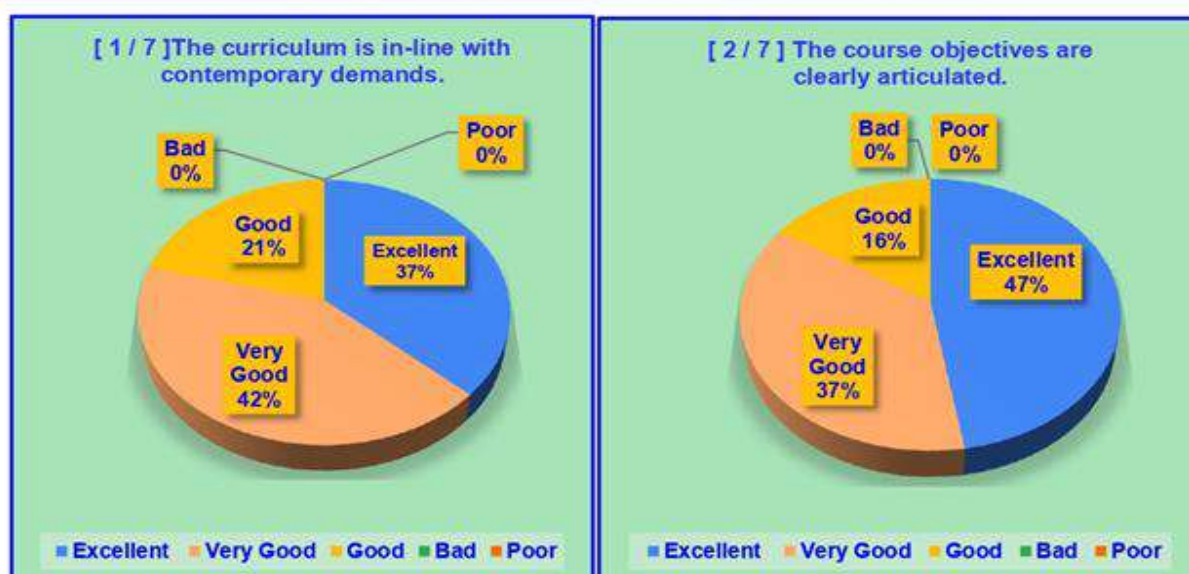

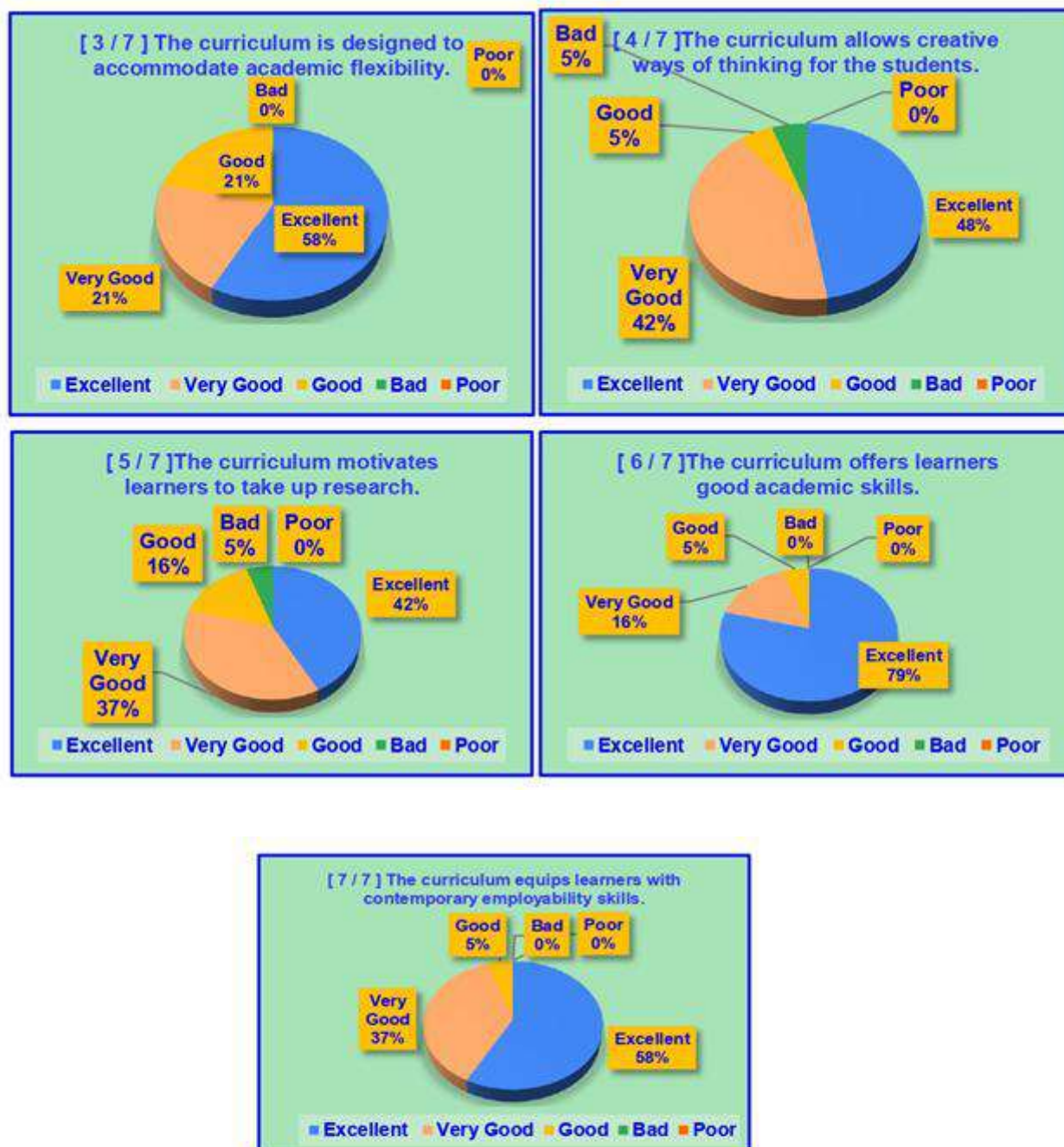
