(1920 - 2020)



Dr. H.Narasimhaiah (1920-2005) was the President of the National Education Society of Karnataka®. Dr. H.N. as he was popularly known, was a true Gandhian, a freedom fighter, an educationist with human values and man of scientific temper. He was teacher par excellence, an able administrator and rose to the position of Vice-Chancellor of Bangalore University and President of Kannada Development Authority of Government of Karnataka. He was a recipient of number of awards such as Tamrapathra for his active participation in Indian freedom movement. He was awarded Rajyotsava Prashathi by Government of Karnataka followed by Naadoja award conferred by Kannada University Hampi for his relentless effort to impart education in Kannada language. His autobiography 'Horatada Haadi' and a thought provoking work 'Tereda Mana' won him the Karnataka Sahitya Academy award. As an embellishment of all these accolades, the Government of India conferred upon him a highest civilian award Padma




Bhushana for his yeoman service to society through education. He established the **Bangalore Science Forum in 1962** to popularize science which won the forum the **Jawaharlal Nehru National Prize in 2002** and **The National Award in 2003 by the Government of India**. He was a patron of drama, art, music and literature gave rise the **Bangalore Lalitha Kala Parishath** housed in the sister institution the National College, Jayanagar. To give a touch of social values, he also founded the **Bangalore Social Sciences Forum in 1992**.

As he was known for his simplicity, but he was also a role model in public life. He was very much concerned and empathetic towards the poor and downtrodden. He was an ardent believer in *value-based education* with regular curriculum. All the educational institutions under the ambit of the National Education Society of Karnataka continuously thrive and follow the legacy, philosophy and ideals for which Dr. H.N. always stood for his entire life.

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Autonomous Status for the College

An important milestone in the history of the College is the grant of Academic Autonomy by the University Grants Commission. A UGC Committee paid a visit to the College in 2004 and after scrutinizing the past achievements and present potentials, it recommended the College to be declared an Autonomous with effect from 2005-06. However, the College decided to implement Autonomy with effect from 2006-2007.

Under the Autonomy status the College has a privilege to frame the syllabus and the same is presented before the Academic Council and Board of Studies and get ratified by the subject experts with a University Nominee and members from high profile corporate sector. The College conducts the examinations as per the well-established norms and announces the results. The College issues marks cards to the student in a stipulated time. Any discrepancies will be attended to by the College examination section. However, the Bangalore University, based on the recommendations of the College, awards the Degree certificates. The University Grants Commission has granted only Academic Autonomy but not the Financial or Administrative Autonomy.

The Autonomous Status granted has helped us to receive various UGC grant-in-aid facilities. In fact the liberal grants sanctioned by the UGC has helped the College to provide various infrastructural facilities in the College.

To function under the Autonomous Educational Institutional Status, is a challenge as well as it is an opportunity for us in our untiring efforts to deliver the 'best' to the student community. Accordingly, the College is equipped with

the best infrastructure and the most advanced syllabi in all disciplines.

Educationists and Scientists of international repute are guiding our academic activities. Vastly experienced and dedicated teaching staff, computerized library and State-of-the-Art laboratory facilities have been our main strength. The College has a well organized Botanical Garden and Zoology Museum. Keeping in mind the contemporary requirements, the College has introduced additional subjects like Communicative English, Computer Basics, and Human Resources Management. The Industry-Institution linkage for interaction, training and placement centres are well within the reach of every student. To facilitate holistic development of students, encouragement is given to co-curricular and extra-curricular activities. The Bangalore Science Forum and The Bangalore Social Sciences Forum, Literary Forums are the three foras housed in the College. Having upgraded our syllabi to meet the overall development of students, we feel proud to state that it has been quite a momentous beginning for us. We have conducted all the tests, examinations as per schedule. In consultation with the industrial entrepreneurs the syllabus preparation has become more relevant. The College is also offering six P.G. Courses. (Kannada, English, Economics, Sociology, Computer Science, and Commerce) The National College, Basavanagudi, being an autonomous College is an apt place for the 'Generation Next'.

Admission Rules & Regulations

1. Application for admission in the prescribed form should reach the Principal on or before the due date specified on the College notice board.
2. **All the benefits and privileges extended by the Govt. to SC/ST/Cat-I and OBC students are made available to them in this College in respect of each course.**
3. Application should be accompanied by **attested copies** of:
 - a) Transfer Certificate from the Institution last attended.
 - b) Marks Card of the previous Examination
 - c) Latest certificates in the case of students belonging to **SC/ST/CAT-1, 2A, 2B, 3A, 3B, Group. OBC** students should submit Income Certificate along with Caste Certificate.
4. Only attested copies of the certificates should be enclosed. The originals should be produced at the time of admission.
5. Students coming from other states must submit Migration and Eligibility Certificates.
6. Change of Optional subjects from Science to Humanities is permitted. However, no such change is permitted from the Humanities to Science subjects.
7. First year Degree applicants must choose the same language that they have studied in the previous class.
8. **Admission fee paid will on no account be refunded.** The fee receipt should be preserved and produced on demand.
9. Names of students provisionally selected for admission will be notified on the College Notice Board and the Principal reserves the right of admission.
10. **All admissions are provisional and are subject to the approval by the Bangalore University**
11. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
12. **Students who have arrears of fees and shortage of attendance will not be permitted to submit their application forms to any of the qualifying examinations.**
13. Students selected for admission should affix a passport size photograph in their application and produce 2 extra copies at the time of admission.

Code of Conduct for Students

1. Students must attend classes regularly.
2. 75% attendance is compulsory for all the subjects (Both Theory & Practicals) Students with less than 75% attendance will not be eligible to appear for the End Semester Examination. If a candidate represents

- the institution / State / Nation in Sports / NCC / NSS / Cultural or any officially sponsored activities he /she may be permitted to claim attendance for actual number of days participated, based on the authentic certificate of participation and recommendation of the Principal.
3. During free time, they are advised to make use of the facilities like library, indoor games, or seek academic assistance from the teachers.
 4. No student should be found loitering in the College premises.
 5. Wearing I.D. Card is a must inside the College.
 6. Visitors (parents, friends, etc) may contact the College Office for any assistance. Such visitors shall not go to the classrooms for any purpose or be found in the quadrangle unauthorisedly. The authorities reserve the right of interrogating or taking suitable action against them.
 7. Students should take their work seriously and respect fellow classmates and teachers and maintain utmost discipline to keep up the dignity and fair name of the institution.
 8. No student is permitted to act indecently or involve in any unruly activity with his or her fellow students.
 9. If a student is found indulging in any act of indifference he/she may be terminated from the College.
 10. Students are allowed to meet the Principal between 3 and 5 p.m.
 11. **Ragging is strictly prohibited, if any Student/s indulging in ragging will be expelled from the College.**
 12. In case there are occasions for any complaint students may feel free to express the same with the authorities directly in person. They are not to seek help on such matters from their fellow classmates or senior students.
 13. **Students are strictly warned not to meddle with electrical installations or carelessly handle instruments supplied for work. Life is precious and so must be guarded.**
 14. Scribbling on walls, desks, or defacing the building is reprehensible and will attract punishment.
 15. Vehicle parking in front of the main gate is prohibited. The Scooter stand must be used to park vehicles to avoid unnecessary problems.
 16. Students should attend the College prayer everyday without fail.
 17. Students are advised to look into the notice board regularly for important announcements.
 18. **Use of Mobile Phone in the College is strictly prohibited.** It will be confiscated by the college authorities.
 19. Attending functions like Independence Day, Republic Day, Gandhi Jayanthi, College Day, etc., and lectures of the Bangalore Science Forum, Bangalore Social Sciences Forum, Sahitya Vedike and other functions of the College is mandatory.

Administration

Terms and conditions to borrow Books & Journals

1. Students may borrow books & journals from Monday to Friday.
2. They may borrow two books at a time, on Barcode system.
3. A student should always possess the College Identity Card issued by the College. The same must be produced at the time of borrowing books, both from the Reference and Borrowing sections.

In case of loss of the original I.D. Card, a duplicate I.D. card will be issued on payment of Rs. 200-00 only.

4. Books should not be sub-lent
5. Any damage or destruction to the barcode label on the book or I.D. Card

will involve a penalty of Rs. 200-00 (Rupees Two Hundred only).

6. If any damage or destruction to the book or other property belonging to the Library is caused by the borrower, he/she shall be required to replace such a book or other property damaged, or pay double the cost of original price. If any volume of a set of book is damaged, the whole set of books must be replaced.
7. Dictionaries, Encyclopedias and such other books are meant only for reference.
8. (a) Books must be returned to the library on the 15th day from the date of borrowing. If books are not returned within the due date, an over due charge of One Rupee per day per book (as indicated by the computer) will be collected from the defaulter.
 (b) Books from book banks may be borrowed for a period of one year and they are returned them at the end of the academic year.
9. (a) On the day of issue, he/she must inspect the pages and bring to the notice of the Library Staff any damage to the book that might have occurred already. Negligence to observe this rule will not be considered.
 (b) Library dues must be cleared immediately. Failure to do so will disqualify students from appearing for the examination.
10. Under special circumstances the Chief Librarian reserves the right to re-call a book before the date of expiry.
11. Any difficulty or grievances felt in utilizing the library should be brought to the notice of the Chief Librarian.

Autonomous College Regulations for All Six Semester Degree Courses

B.Sc. / B.A. / B.C.A. and B.Com

(Excerpts from the Regulations Manual adopted at the time of the beginning the Autonomous Courses in the College)

1. Attendance :

- ❖ Each semester shall be taken as a unit for the purpose of calculating attendance.
- ❖ A student shall be considered to have satisfied the requirement of attendance for the semester, if he/she has attended not less than 75% of the number of classes in theory and practicals separately, in each subject.
- ❖ A Candidate shall be considered to have undergone the prescribed Course of Study if the candidate has attended at least 75% of the classes in each subject (Theory, Lab), otherwise the candidate shall not be allowed to appear for the End Semester Examination and has to repeat the Semester in the ensuing academic year.

Marks for attendance under CIA (Continuous Internal Assessment) will be awarded in proportion to the attendance over 75%

2. Internal Assessment :

- ❖ Continuous Internal Assessment of students is done. The total marks allotted for internal assessment is 30 marks for subjects with theory and 40+10 marks for subjects with practicals.

- ❖ Aggregate for a pass is 40% in the total of the subjects in Parts I & II.
- ❖ Student who falls short of 40% in aggregate can appear for any subject (Theory and Practical) of his/her choice to pass the End Semester Examination.
- ❖ Students need to get a minimum of 35% to pass in Part III. (Additional Papers) The marks obtained in this

paper will not be considered for declaration of Class and for the total aggregate required for pass.

- ❖ Students who obtain passing marks in theory but fail in practical need to appear for practical paper alone and vice-versa.
- ❖ Students who are absent for theory or practical paper in a subject have to take up only that paper.

5. Eligibility for admission to V Semester :

- ❖ Students who have cleared all the subjects of I & II Semesters and should not have failed in more than 4 papers of III & IV Semesters together shall be eligible to attend V Semester.

6. Rules

- Provisional Results of each semester will be announced within 30 days after the completion of the examinations.
- Semester Marks Cards will be issued within 8 days of the announcement of results.

• A **Supplementary Examination** will be conducted for the failed students in each Semester within three weeks after the results are announced.

• Supplementary Exam is meant only for the students who fail in the Main Exam.

• However those who do not qualify for the Main Exam, due to attendance shortage are not eligible for the suppl. exam. They can take the exam, only after ONE year. Students are required to take serious note of this.

• Request for Revaluation should be made within 7 days from the date of

issue of the marks card along with the fee notified by the Controller of Examinations.

- Failed candidates should appear for arrears as follows:

Odd Semester — Next Odd Semester

Even Semester — Next Even Semester

B.C.A. Course

Bachelor of Computer Application is a Technical Course for Six Semesters.

Eligibility For Admission : A candidate with PUC or 10+2 or equivalent there to with a minimum of 40% of marks in the aggregate of all subject including languages is eligible for admission to BCA Course. Relaxation to SC/ST, Group I, be extended as per norms.

Special Remedial Coaching Classes

Special Coaching is provided for Slow-Learners in English and core subjects.

Institution - Industry Linkage

M.A in Sociology

The main aim of MA is to provide a thorough grounding in the historical and theoretical development in the field of Sociology and to give students the tools to make this knowledge relevant. The programme seeks to provide students with the theories and methods to develop new forms of Sociological study that will cross disciplinary boundaries and/or sub-areas of the field in innovative and imaginative ways through sustained treatment of a single topic.

Eligibility Criteria for Admission:

- a) A candidate, who has passed the three year B.A Examination of any recognized University or equivalent thereto with Sociology as one of the core subjects, shall be eligible for admission to M.A. in Sociology Course.
- b) A General merit candidate should have secured at least 50% marks in aggregate and 55% in Sociology in the degree course. For candidates belonging to SC/ST/BT and OBC, it is relaxed to 45% both in aggregate marks and marks secured in Sociology.

M.Sc. in Computer Science Regulations for the Two Years (Four Semesters)

1. Eligibility:

A candidate, passed the three year B.Sc Examination from any of the recognized University or equivalent

there of with Computer Science as one of the core subjects, shall be eligible for admission.

- a) A General merit candidate should have secured at least 50% marks in aggregate and 55% in the Computer Science subjects in the degree course. For candidates belonging to SC/ST/BT and OBC, it is relaxed to 45% both in aggregate marks and marks secured in Computer science.
- b) Completed 20 years of age at the time of admission or will complete this age on or before 31st December of the year of admission.

Medium of Instruction:

The medium of instruction and Examination shall be English only.

Attendance:

Each semester shall be taken as a unit for the purpose of calculating attendance.

A student shall be considered to have satisfied the requirement of attendance for the semester, if he/she has attended not less than 75% of the number of classes in theory and practicals separately, in each of the subjects.

A student who fails to satisfy the above conditions shall not be allowed to take the End Semester Examinations.

Marks for attendance under CIA [Continuous Internal Assessment] will be awarded in proportion to the attendance over 75%.

End Semester Examination:

Notification for the End Semester Examination will be issued 30 days before the commencement of the examination.

Students are required to pay the prescribed fee and submit the application form at the

office of the Controller of Examinations (COE) within the dates notified.

Students, who do not pay the prescribed end semester examination fee for any semester, shall repeat the semester.

A student who has failed in a subject can attempt the same 3 times.

Practical examination will be conducted before the commencement of the theory examination.

Failed candidates should appear for arrears as follows:

Odd Semester — Next Odd Semester

Even Semester — Next Even Semester

Students who have cleared a minimum of 4 papers of I & II semester together shall be eligible for III Semester.

Process of Assessment:

Examinations are conducted with utmost care in the College. The College conducts two centralized tests in a semester for 30 marks in each subject. The end semester examination is conducted for 70 marks in each subject. Practical examinations are conducted for 70 marks, 30 marks are allotted for internal assessment which takes into consideration marks obtained at the tests, practical tests, attendance and assignments. One minor project and two seminars are valued for 50 marks each. The internal assessment is calculated on the basis of the following points:

Attendance : 5 Marks

Assignments : 5 Marks

Two Internal assessment tests : (10+10) = 20 Marks, Total - 30 marks

The College monitors student progression by continuous evaluation of performance and attendance. The faculty guides students to ensure their progress at each stage.

The Internal Assessment marks shall be displayed in the Department Notice Board and a copy of the same should be sent to Controller of Examinations, at least one week before the commencement of the End Semester Examination.

The attendance of the students is strictly monitored. The attendance status of the student is announced at the end of every month. The College do inform the Parents about the attendance shortage of the student through the class teacher. Students who do not have a minimum 75% of attendance are not allowed to appear for the final examination.

There shall be a double valuation by Internal as well as External teachers. Average marks of both valuers will be taken as the marks secured for each paper. The difference between the two valuers exceeding 15% of the maximum marks scored, the College will setup the third board valuation. The board consists of Chairperson of the Department, Paper Setter and the external member. Marks allotted by the Board shall be final.

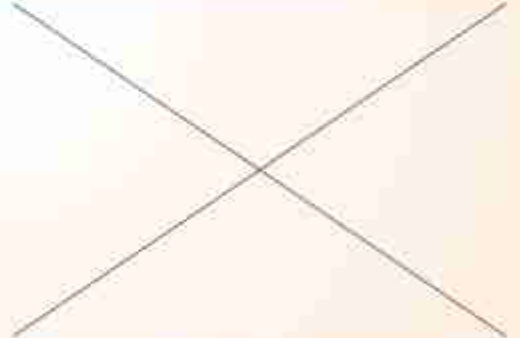
