

#### STUDENTS' FEEDBACK REPORT

The majority of students (56%) rated the syllabus as Excellent, while 30% found the content provided in the syllabus to be Very Good. Additionally, 12% of respondents rated the courses as Good. The feedback revealed that 1% of students rated the syllabus as Bad, and another 1% rated it as Poor. The analysis of students' feedback clearly indicates a high level of satisfaction with the curriculum development and revision. However, some students expressed a need for more classroom learning-centric facilities.



# Overall Alumni Feedback Response



The feedback from alumni indicates that 53% rated the syllabus as Excellent, while 31% found the content provided in the syllabus to be Very Good. Additionally, 15% of respondents rated the courses as Good. The feedback also revealed that 1% of alumni rated the syllabus as Bad, with none rating it as Poor.

The analysis of the alumni feedback clearly shows a high level of satisfaction with the curriculum development and revision. However, some alumni suggested the need to better articulate course objectives.

Given the crucial role teachers play in designing and implementing the curriculum, their feedback was carefully reviewed and will be used to inform necessary actions where applicable



The majority of teachers (50%) rated the syllabus as Excellent, while 36% found the content to be Very Good. Additionally, 14% of respondents rated the courses as Good. The feedback revealed that none of the teachers rated the syllabus as Bad or Poor.

The analysis of the teachers' feedback clearly indicates a high level of satisfaction with the curriculum development and revision. However, some teachers suggested the need to allocate appropriate hours for each unit, both for theory and practical sessions. Various recommendations for modifications to the curricular content have been noted for further action.

The majority of employers (52%) rated the syllabus as Excellent, with 30% finding the content provided in the syllabus to be Very Good. Additionally, 16% of respondents rated the courses as Good. The feedback also revealed that 1% of employers rated the syllabus as Bad, and another 1% rated it as Poor.

The analysis of employers' feedback indicates a high level of satisfaction with the curriculum development and revision. However, some feedback highlighted the need for the curriculum to better align with contemporary demands. The feedback report will be presented to the academic council and governing body to facilitate continuous improvement in areas where performance is lacking.
